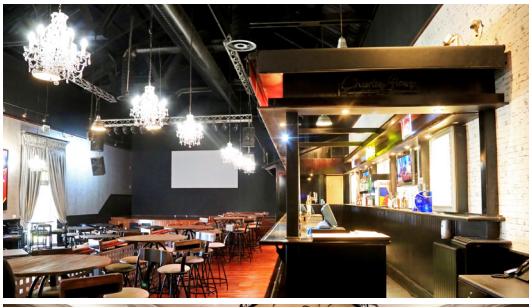

## Things To Do

- Kimberley Golf Course – opened in 1890, the Kimberley golf club is steeped in history, and offers a challenging course for guests at the Flamingo Casino.
- Kamfers Dam – a 400 hectare expanse of water and wetland is home to breeding pairs of lesser flamingos who collectively offer a spectacular sight to behold for both tourists and locals alike.
- Visit the Big Hole in Kimberley, where you will see the largest man-made hole in the world as well as the largest diamond display in the world.
- The Kimberley Mine Museum – an astonishing crater from which over 22 million tons of earth has been removed by hand.
- Visit the William Humphreys Art Gallery which houses both European and South African art and sculptures.
- Wildebeest Kuil Rock Art Centre – a rock engraving site on land owned by the !Xun and Khwe San, and declared a provincial heritage site. The engravings illustrate one of the forms often referred to as ‘Bushman rock art’ or Khoe-San rock art.
- Magersfontein Battlefield – visitors can view numerous artefacts from the battlefield.
